A LETTER FROM OUR CEO

To Our Ministry Friends and Partners,

None of us will soon forget, if ever, living through the year of 2020! Serving in our 27th year of ministry, we were presented challenges we never anticipated, yet we marvel at the faithfulness of God in His constant guidance and provision for our needs. We all quickly added the words "adaptation" and "pivot" to our daily vocabulary and truly learned to take one day at a time. I am grateful for the lessons the Lord taught us in 2020. Our staff learned to lean into the Lord at a whole new level – to walk in faith over fear. We became not only familiar with, but accustomed to trusting in the Unseen over the seen. These are lessons we will carry individually and as an organization for a lifetime.

Our projected plans to open a new satellite location were realized. "Not by might, not by power, but My Spirit," said the Lord. He made a way to open our new Southwest Dallas location in the second most abortion-dense zip code in Dallas County, located just 3/10 of a mile from Planned Parenthood's surgical center where they perform 6,000+ abortions each year. We plan to further expand services at this location in 2021.

Telemedicine became a new path for us to reach patients who were afraid to leave their homes yet needed medical help. When our very popular Prenatal and Parenting Classes could no longer be safely offered in person, we adapted our program to be offered via Zoom. As the need for material assistance became even greater through loss of jobs due to business closings, we developed a new curbside delivery service of diapers, wipes, layette items, car seats and cribs for those enrolled in our educational programs.

And we enter 2021 with great expectation and hope! Not because the pandemic has yet subsided, the economy has rebounded or the political climate looks good, but because the Lord has assured us His mercies endure forever. In courage and full trust in the Lord, our Board is answering the call for more help needed in our North Texas community. We have begun plans to add another satellite location, this time in Garland!

We give all praise to the Lord for all He has done and will do! The Board and Staff of Involved for Life are truly grateful for your prayers, words of encouragement and financial support.

INVOLVED FOR LIFE CHANGING THE RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

Taking a page from the marketing playbook of Planned Parenthood, the main organization with whom we compete for the right to serve women, we realize that in order to engage with the patients we most need to serve, we have to be their first point of contact. As young women become sexually active in either their high school or college years, most realize a need for an inexpensive place to receive introductory reproductive health services such as STD screenings and contraception. Many choose to go to Planned Parenthood because of their perceived affordable cost and "no judgment" attitude.

At Involved for Life we provide our services at no or low cost to our patients. And each woman is accepted in a "judgment-free zone" where they receive services provided with compassion through the work of the Spirit of Jesus Christ.

Our number one difference from PP is each woman is treated with high value because we recognize she is made in the image of God. The second difference from our abortion-providing competitor is we do not profit from her decision.

To an abortion provider a woman is a transaction. To our ministry, we seek to provide a transformation from hopelessness to a life plan that has direction, support and a path for her wholeness – physically, emotionally and spiritually.

Involved for Life is proactively providing a unique place for women, going beyond the services previously offered to her in her reproductive years by other agencies.

Why do we use this approach?

One of our compelling reasons for offering medical services wrapped in compassionate support services and education is the startling numbers of maternal mortality we have in the United States. Of first world countries, the U.S. leads in the number of women who are dying in the months leading up to giving birth and following delivery. And sadly, Texas is number three in that heartbreaking statistic in our nation.

Studies show many contributing factors to these alarming rates. While many factors are medical conditions, there are equally compelling circumstances that surround lifestyle choices, inability to handle stress, and lack of education and support for moms and their children to not only survive, but to thrive. Educating women to recognize these factors in her life before she becomes pregnant, and educating her how to make small, progressive changes in her lifestyle choices that will positively impact her health are key to breaking this downward spiral.

Addressing a woman's mental and emotional health in concert with her physical health brings opportunity to encourage her to choose a lifestyle which will give her the whole health she desires. Of course, the One resource that ties all these factors together is an authentic and growing relationship with her Creator, Jesus Christ.

The Lifestyle Medical Model is interwoven throughout our non-medical consultations, our social services, and our healthcare services to create a supportive system to educate, inform and coach a woman to find the tools she needs to achieve her best life.

Returning to a Safe Place

Maria* visited us in the earlier part of last year after finding out she was pregnant. She came to us distraught because she believed her stress-filled circumstances left her no choice but abortion. She disclosed her son was struggling with drug and alcohol addiction and had recently run away from home. She was heartsick with worry. Additionally, her father-in-law recently had experienced a massive stroke, which put additional heartache and stress on her family.

Because Maria had come to us years ago for help with her pregnancy with her now nine-year-old daughter, she returned to us hoping to find the same love and acceptance she had received previously. Maria sadly confessed because of current traumatic family events, combined with her older age and high blood pressure, she felt carrying and parenting this baby could not be an option for her. She reluctantly shared her husband agreed with her decision.

For the next month following her visit, we continued to follow up with Maria, providing a caring, listening ear and offering helpful community and counseling resources. After a month of phone conversations, Maria reached out to us asking if we had any maternity clothing. We were excited about the request and inquired if this meant she had decided to parent. Thankfully, she answered, "Yes!"

When asked what had prompted her change of mind, Maria noted the many phone conversations she experienced with our various staff members and also seeing the fetal models during her sonogram appointment. She additionally confided that when she saw "hands and legs" during her sonogram, she was assured her baby was more than a "ball of cells." She explained that the ongoing dialogues with our staff made her feel loved and cared for and that she had conveyed this information to her husband.

Once Maria felt empowered and equipped to continue forward, her husband agreed with her decision to carry the baby in her womb. Despite the limitations brought by the pandemic, she enjoyed participating in the many resources we offered to prepare her for motherhood again.

2020 brought an increase in the number of married women we served as many couples felt overwhelmed by the fear of disease, were impacted by job loss, and were distressed with the cultural and political unrest in our country. We were pleased to be open every single day in 2020 as an essential service provider to women like Maria.


