P.S. This is what you may expect during the process:

- 1. After we receive the application, we will review it carefully and run your references.
- 2. After we receive your references, we will contact you and may invite you in for an interview.
- 3. We will run 3 background checks. One will take approximately 30-40 days before you will receive the clearance back. That is to be submitted back to me.
- 4. Once those have been completed, you will be invited to come in to begin a self-paced training which will include a review of our literature, videos and shadowing a staff member.


Auxiliary Member: Provide refreshments for center activities & baby showers




