P.S. This is what you may expect during the process:

1. After we receive the application, we will review it carefully and run your references.
2. After we receive your references, we will contact you and may invite you in for an interview.
3. We will run 3 background checks. One will take approximately 30-40 days before you will receive the clearance back. That is to be submitted back to me.
4. Once those have been completed, you will be invited to come in to begin a self-paced training which will include a review of our literature, videos and shadowing a staff member.



SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

- Auxiliary Member: Provide refreshments for center activities & baby showers
- Board Member: Serve on the board of directors to help facilitate operations and guidance
- Clerical Support: Making copies, stapling, collating, shredding, helping with mail-outs, etc.
- Event Support: Help with fundraising events, i.e. dinner and/or golf event
- Group Facilitator (female): Facilitate women’s classes from a secular perspective on personal/family health or prenatal class
- Group Facilitator (male): Facilitate men’s classes from a secular perspective on parenting and marriage
- *Individual Education/Mentor: Providing support one on one with parenting & prenatal videos/material
- Medical Support: Clinic (nurse, nurse practitioner, PA, phlebotomist, RDMS, ob-gyn, etc.)
- Men’s Ministry: Men working with men in Bible study, prayer, book study, discipleship
- Serve on ministry prayer chain/committee to pray for specific clients, needs of the ministry and do spiritual warfare
- Resale Shop: Work on a team for (future) resale shop or at the resale shop
- Sexual Education: Presenting sexual integrity in schools, churches, client classes
- Social Media: Blogging, tweeting, posting on Facebook and website updates
- *Spiritual Support: Sharing the gospel, praying with client, devotion leader for Prenatal Classes, and/or Bible Study leader
- *Wee Care Shoppe: Help inventory, sort and organize donated items; working a weekly shift in the store; cleaning, washing, mending donated items; helping clients with their selections
- Women’s Ministry: Women working with women in Bible study, prayer, book study, discipleship

DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

SANCTITY OF LIFE
