
Your support empowers us to push forward against the negative cultural tide, continuing to deliver the truth to our patients that they are

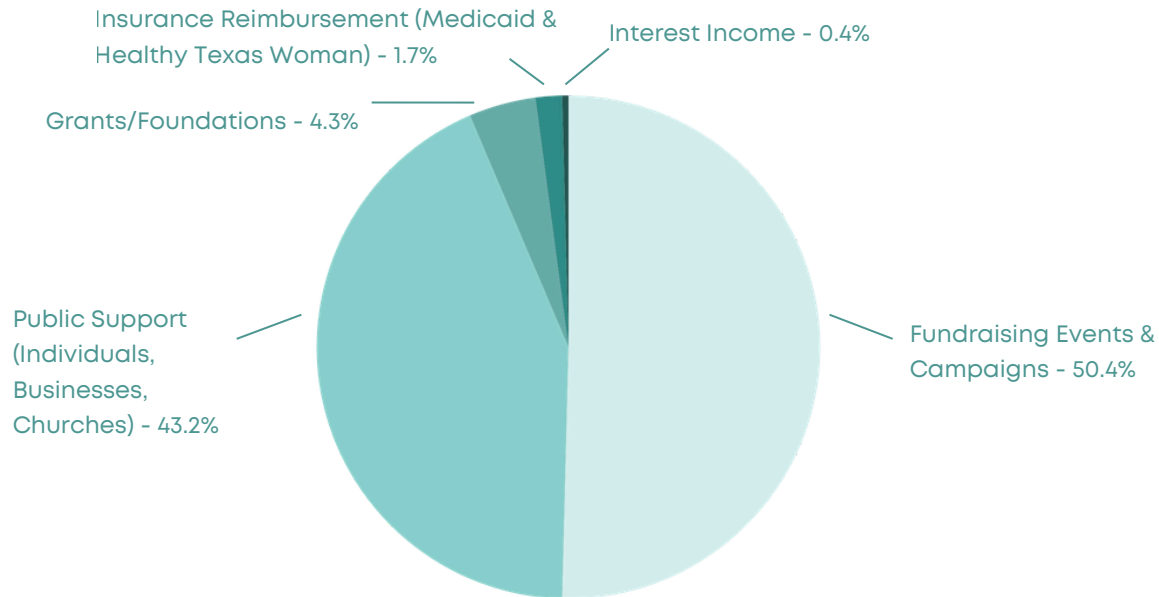

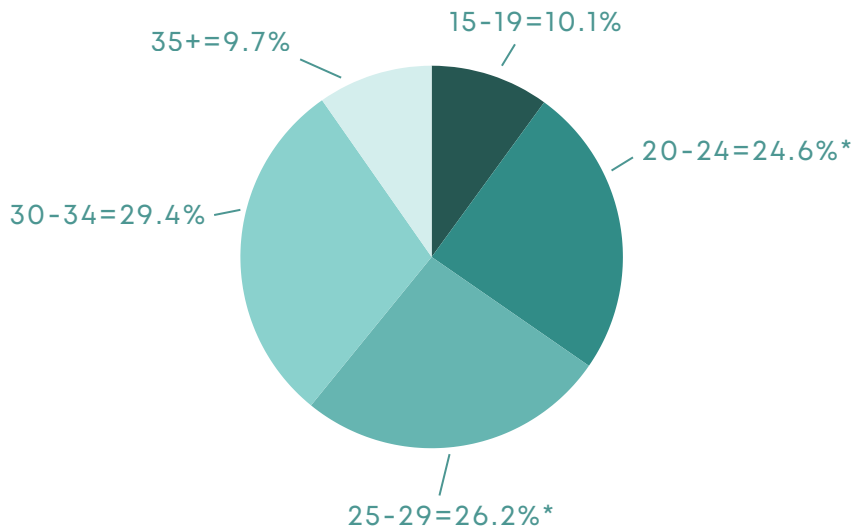

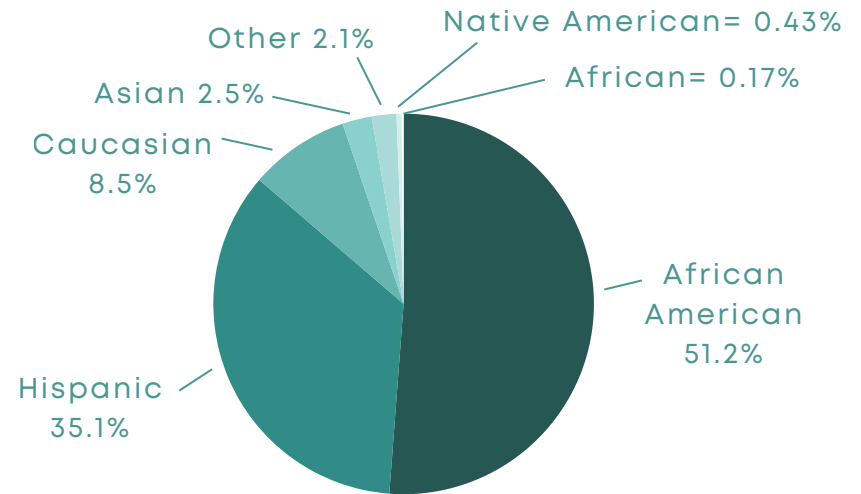

The vast majority of these legal abortions were obtained out of state. These numbers do not account for the large numbers of women having undocumented chemical abortions in their own homes within the state. Those numbers are not included in any official statistics as these are women going through self-induced abortions from drugs delivered via mail without medical supervision.

\*75201 is the zip code of our downtown Dallas location. This is the highest number of patients ever served in our “neighborhood” demonstrating the change of downtown Dallas from solely a business district to the large expansion of residential space. Many of these patients simply walk to us from their high-rise dwellings.

My wife, Maria, and I experienced two unplanned pregnancies early in our marriage. We understand firsthand the fear, pressure, and uncertainty that come with a crisis pregnancy.

Fifteen years ago, after hearing our CEO, Carolyn Cline, share about Involved for Life during a church service, I felt called to serve. Maria and I began volunteering at the clinic — she supported women clients, and I spoke with

the men who accompanied them. We served faithfully for over three years.

# DRILLING DOWN

## To the Heart of the Matter

Serving in the medical field of reproductive healthcare can be challenging and rarely comes with easy answers. Our discussions walk through questions from women who need truthful, medically accurate information as they make difficult decisions regarding their personal health, the future of their undesired pregnancy, or decisions that will impact the relationships they currently have.

Approximately two-thirds of the women we served in 2025 came to our centers to gather the information they felt they needed regarding pregnancy options for an unplanned pregnancy. Seventeen percent of those women specifically requested information about the “abortion pill”, a self-directed two-day chemical process to end their unwanted pregnancy in the privacy of their home. Some already had the pills in their possession, and others were waiting for delivery from an online order or had a “friend” who was going to provide them. These women were given the factual information they requested, along with life-saving alternatives and support offered so they might choose to continue their pregnancies.

# ABORTION PILL

## *Reversal*

As part of the national Abortion Pill Reversal hotline, we have women in North Texas who had begun the two-day abortion process then had a change of heart and were referred to us for the Abortion Pill Reversal medical intervention process. In 2025, we were privileged to serve 7 women with APR appointments with a 71% success rate resulting in an ongoing, healthy pregnancy.

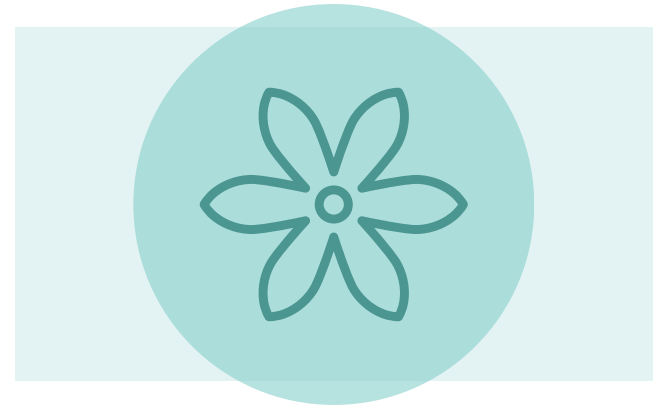


# POST ABORTION

## *Care*



Several years ago we prayerfully decided one of the most compassionate services we could offer was post-abortion examinations. We see women when they are at their lowest emotionally, and often in a weakened state physically after going through an abortion out of state or without medical supervision by self-administering a chemical abortion in the solace of their homes. Although these are often difficult appointments, we were privileged to serve 82 women last year with the services they needed for their physical, emotional, and spiritual health. We were able to provide needed medical intervention and share the hope and forgiveness offered through the gospel, along with referrals to post-abortion recovery programs.

Transformed by God's Love



When Alicia\* came to our center, her suspected pregnancy was confirmed, although she was unsure of the identity of the potential father between the two men she had been with. Alicia professed to be a Christian and was about to start graduate school to pursue a calling she felt from the Lord to become a Bible teacher. However, it seemed to her that abortion was the logical solution to this untimely problem.

Alicia returned to our center several times over the next couple months for additional ultrasounds and discussions. When asked if she had made a decision to carry her pregnancy, her response was still that she was processing. Our staff member lovingly reminded her that God is the Creator of all life, and He is the one Who knows the future plans for Alicia and her child. She could trust that He was already in tomorrow with the answers if she would choose to walk in His ways.

At twelve weeks, Alicia shared the great news with us that she had scheduled her first appointment with an Ob-Gyn. We rejoice in her decision for life for her baby, and we thank God for the precious tool of ultrasound that helped connect Alicia with her baby as she processed her decision. We continue to pray she will open her heart to what she is reading in God's Word, and that her knowledge will not be only confined to book learning but a heart transformation that will help her to choose to walk in His Light.

# Staff SPOTLIGHT

Serving on the Front Lines



Nelida (Nelly to her friends) Lopez has been on our Woman to Woman Health Center (W2WHC) staff for a little over three years as a Patient Services Specialist. She came to us with 16 years of experience serving in pro-life ministry.

Nelly said when she started working in prolife ministry almost 19 years ago, she was looking for a job that could provide support for her as a single mom. But not long into serving she found her voice not only for herself, but for the other single moms she was serving who were full of fear and self-doubt. She said God broke her heart for what broke His and that was women who were so anxious and broken that they were considering ending the life of their child through abortion.

Nelly believes God gave her a tender heart for women in crisis who were operating in the fear of not being able to care for their child as a single mom. As Nelly was experiencing God's faithfulness in her own family, she was able to genuinely state to women that God is faithful to provide for those who trust in Him.

Nelly says she loves serving with W2WHC as a bilingual Patient Services Specialist because of the ministry's emphasis on serving women at their point of need, truly listening to their personal stories, and guiding them to positive choices and growth. She loves seeing the



change in their countenance from the time they enter with fear and worry, to leaving with hope feeling empowered by the knowledge they gained and the support they needed to face their challenging circumstances.

The strong unity of the W2WHC team who have one desire of putting Christ on display each day is one of Nelly's favorite reasons she loves serving on our staff. The solid connection between the Patient Services department and the Clinic Staff provides patients a safe place to make courageous choices. Nelly says, "Hearing women express how loved and cared for they feel within our centers gives me great joy."

What's Nelly's favorite part of her day? She loves it when she has opportunity to pray with our patients. She recently served a woman who stated she used to be a Christian but now professes to be an atheist. At the conclusion of Nelly's session with her, she asked the patient if she might pray for her. The young woman initially said no and asked why Nelly would do that. Nelly stated, "I told her the Bible says we are to love one another and I love you, so I would like to pray for you." The woman then gave permission and thanked Nelly "for her beautiful prayer" when she finished.

We are so thankful Nelly brings her tender heart, bilingual skills, and passion for Christ to our Southwest and Downtown Clinics each day! What a blessing she is to our patients.

# LOOKING *ahead*



2025 was the year our Her Health Matters fundraising began in earnest through our Capital Campaign to open our third location that will be located at 1014 Main Street in Garland to serve eastern Dallas, Collin, Rockwall, and Kaufman Counties. As we continue to grow, our mission remains the same: to serve women through the provision of spiritual care, love, and compassionate reproductive health services, ensuring they have the means to live healthy and empowered lives.

A spacious one-story building has been purchased; interior demolition has taken place to make way for a first-class charitable medical clinic. All new electrical wiring has been installed, new plumbing lines have been run, a new HVAC system has been delivered and activated, and the initial framing of walls has been completed. As funds are raised, they do not sit idle in a bank account, but are immediately applied to the next project on the punch list to finish-out the building with multiple exam and counseling rooms, a laboratory for in-house testing, a conference/education space, nurse work stations, counseling work room, and provider and staff offices.

In this coming year, we will continue our fundraising and friend-raising to add cabinetry and plumbing to the walled-out exam and



counseling rooms, medical grade flooring, finish-out of restrooms, kitchen, prayer room, and staff offices. Additional funding will provide furniture, fixtures, medical and office equipment and supplies. The outside activities of painting, ADA accessible sidewalks, a prayer garden, and flagpoles will follow.

As we continue to serve, we stand firm in the belief that by caring for women's health in body, mind, and spirit, we pro-actively display the gospel in action by serving as Jesus' healing heart and hands.

We are so grateful for your past support and invite you to be a part of God's future transformative work as we link arms together to expand His kingdom.
